- **Prayer shawls and scarves**

- **Birthday placemats for the nursing home residents**
- **Hat and scarf sets for the Rosebud Episcopal Mission for Lakota Native Americans and for some metro homeless (we buy the gloves and make some mittens.)**
- **Baby blankets for the S.E. Co-Op, the car show and the preschool silent auction**
- **Other items: Thousands of items (i.e., holiday pins and ornaments, purses, pumpkins, earrings, ...) have been created by our group over the years.**

Approximate Number of Items Distributed this Year:
