

## Lap Robe Pattern

### Materials

K/6.5mm Crochet Hook; 3 Skeins Big Twist Rainbow Classic, Bulky [5] weight yarn, 100% acrylic yarn, 11 oz/312 g; 615 y/562 m, shown in Royal Blue, Gray, and Green; Yarn Needle; Scissors

### Abbreviations

Ch- chain;  
Dc – double crochet;  
Hdc- half double crochet;  
Sc- single crochet;  
Sk- skip;  
StDc- Standing double crochet;  
St- stitch;

### Finished Size

Finished blanket measures approximately 36" x 48".

### Special Stitches

**Standing Double Crochet:** tie a slipknot on your hook and pull tight, yarn over your hook, then insert your hook into stitch indicated; yarn over and pull up a loop, then (yarn over and pull through two loops) twice to complete the stitch.

**Puff Stitch:** (Yarn over, insert hook into the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through two loops) 5 times total, yarn over and pull through all but two loops on your hook, yarn over and pull through last two loops to complete the stitch.

### Notes

This blanket is worked in a randomized color and texture combo. You can substitute stitch textures and colors to suit your own tastes and yarn supply.



### Easy Textured Crochet Lap Blanket Pattern

With Green yarn:  
Ch 102.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook and across. [100]  
*Alternately, you may work 100 foundation double crochet.*

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, dc in each st across. [100]

Rows 3-6: Repeat Row 2.  
Fasten off.

With Gray yarn:  
Row 7: Work a standing dc in first st, dc in each st across. [100]

Rows 8-12: Repeat Row 2.  
Fasten off.

With Green yarn:

Row 13: Repeat row 7.

Row 14: Ch 2, turn, dc 6, \*(ch 1, sk 1, dc) 4 times, dc in next 8 sts, \* repeat \* to \* 4 more times (five times total), (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 4 times, dc in last 6 sts. [6 sets of filet sts, 100 dc + ch]

Row 15: Ch 2, turn, dc in first 7 sts, \*(ch 1, sk 1, dc) 4 times, dc in next 8 sts, \* repeat \* to \* 4 more times (five times total), (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 4 times, dc in last 5 sts. [6 sets of filet sts, 100 dc + ch]

Rows 16-17: Repeat Rows 14-15.

Row 18: Ch 2, turn, dc in first 2 sts, (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 2 times, \*dc in next 8 sts, (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 4 times, \* repeat \* to \* 4 more times (5 times total), dc next 8 sts, (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 2 times, dc in last 2 sts. [5 sets of 4 filet sts, 100 dc + ch]

Row 19: Ch 2, turn, dc in first 3 sts, (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 2 times, \*dc in next 8 sts, (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 4 times, \* repeat \* to \* 4 more times (5 times total), dc next 8 sts, (ch 1, sk 1, dc) 2 times, dc in last st. [5 sets of 4 filet sts, 100 dc + ch]

Rows 20-21: Repeat Rows 18-19.

Row 22: Repeat Row 2.

Fasten off.

With Blue yarn:

Row 23: Stdc into first st, dc in next 7 sts, \*sk 1, dc, cross behind and dc in sk st, \* repeat \* to \* until 8 sts remain, dc in last 8 sts. [100]

Row 24: Ch 2, dc in 1st st, dc in next 7 sts, \*sk 1, dc, cross behind and dc in sk st, \* repeat \* to \* until 8 sts remain, dc in last 8 sts. [100]

Fasten off.

With Green yarn:

Row 25: Stdc into first st, dc in next 7 sts, \*sk 1, 3dc in next st, sk 1,\* repeat \* to \* across until 8 sts remain, dc in last 8 sts. [28 3dc groups or 100 dc]

Row 26: Ch 2, turn, dc in first 8 sts, \*ch 1, dc3tog, ch 1,\* repeat \* to \* across until 8 sts remain, dc in last 8 sts. [28 dc3tog and 16 dc]

Fasten off.

With Blue yarn:

Row 27: Stdc into first st, dc in each st and around each ch across. [100]

Rows 28-30: Ch 2, turn, dc in each st across. [100]

Fasten off.

With Green yarn:

Rows 31-40: Repeat Rows 13-22.

Fasten off.

With Blue yarn:

Row 41: Stdc into first st, dc in next 7 sts, \*dc, puff, dc,\* repeat \* to \* across until 8 sts remain, dc in last 8 sts. [100 sts]

Row 42: Ch 2, turn, dc in each st across. [100]

Row 43: Ch 2, turn, dc in first 8 sts, \*dc, puff, dc,\* repeat \* to \* across until 8 sts remain, dc in last 8 sts. [100 sts]

Fasten off.

With Green yarn:

Row 44: Stdc into first st, dc in each st across.

Row 45: Ch 2, turn, dc in first 8 sts, \*ch 1, sk 1, dc,\* repeat \* to \* across until 8 sts remain, dc in last 8 sts. [58 dc, 42 ch]

Row 46: Ch 2, turn, dc in each st across. [100]

Fasten off.

With Gray yarn:

Row 47: Stdc into first st, dc in each st across. [100]

Row 48: Ch 2, turn, dc in each st across. [100]

Fasten off.

With Blue yarn:

Rows 49-58: Repeat Rows 13-22.

Fasten off.

With Green yarn:

Row 59: Stdc into first st, dc in each st across. [100]

Rows 60-64: Ch 2, turn, dc in each st across. [100]

Fasten off.

With Blue yarn:

Rows 65-70: Repeat Rows 59-64. [100]

Finishing:

Fasten off and weave in all ends. Wash or block lightly if desired.
